All country delegations may have between 4 and 6 delegates (7 if the country is both in ECO and in SC). Each delegate is in a different committee.

Amnesty International, Greenpeace, Palestine, World Bank and WTO are represented by 2 delegates each, Amnesty in Social and Humanitarian Committee, Greenpeace in Environmental and Cultural Committee, Palestine in Political Committee, World Bank and WTO in ECOSOC. As they are no Members of the UN, they cannot vote, but they are very important for the discussion of various topics, and therefore their voice must be heard. They can sign and present resolutions.

The Security Council is an emergency organ. Delegates must be very well prepared and aware of the general situation of world politics as a crisis situation may occur which has to be dealt with.
